## **PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES OF THE CONFERENCE:**

The purpose of the conference is:

- formation of a permanent open platform for organizing discussions between specialists and scientists who strive to generate and disseminate new creative ideas, innovative scientific developments, knowledge and practices in forensic and law enforcement activities;
- improving the efficiency of expert support of legal proceedings;
- assistance in the development of forensic expert and evaluation activities;
- representation and implementation of professional, intellectual and scientific interests of specialists of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Scientific Research Center;
- publication and testing of the results of scientific research and scientific and methodological activities of specialists of the Expert Service of the Ministry of Internal Affairs and other participants of the Conference;
- coordination of the improvement of the activities of forensic experts in the areas of expert research, aimed at the development of their scientific initiatives and professional growth.

**The objectives of the conference are:**

- involvement and integration of specialists of the Ministry of Internal Affairs Research Center in scientific activities, exchange of experience and the possibility of communication with experts and scientists of other institutions, including other countries, representatives of higher educational institutions and units of the National Police of Ukraine;
- assistance in the integration of specialists of the Ministry of Internal Affairs Research and Development Center into the professional sphere at the regional, national and international levels;
- support of a high level of quality of scientific developments related to the professional activities of forensic experts;
- creating conditions for the implementation of innovative, scientific and professional potential of specialists of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Scientific Research and Development Center;
- informing about the current state and forecasting promising areas for the development of expert activities, legislative initiatives.

## **THEMATIC AREAS OF THE CONFERENCE:**

1. Theoretical and legal support of law enforcement activities in Ukraine.
2. Topical issues of law enforcement activities, ensuring public order and security in the conditions of martial law.
3. Protection of constitutional rights and freedoms of a person and a citizen in judicial practice and in law enforcement activities.
4. Problems of conducting proceedings in cases of administrative offenses.
5. Scientific and pedagogical approach in the prevention of offenses among students.

6. Problems of formation and improvement of certain forensic techniques and the use of special knowledge in criminal proceedings.

7. Improving the organization of forensic activities: problems of theory and practice.

8. Modern problems of regulatory regulation of the sphere of technical-forensic and forensic support of justice.

9. Problematic aspects of the methodology of forensic examination.

10. International experience and prospects for the development of forensic expertise.

11. Issues of improving education, professional training and advanced training of specialists of expert institutions and police officers.

12. Economic security and state regulation of the economy.

13. Current problems of enterprises in the context of the transformation of national legislation to the standards of the European Union.

14. Modern problems and prospects of accounting, taxation, analysis, audit, finance, management, information economy

15. Medical care and medical services: problems and prospects of legal regulation.

16. Problematic issues of activity of government agencies and local self-government agencies in the conditions of martial law.

#### **THE PROCEDURE FOR SUBMITTING MATERIALS:**

To participate in the conference meeting, you must send an email to the organizing committee **by March 25, 2022** (included) [kf.kp.ndekc@gmail.com](mailto:kf.kp.ndekc@gmail.com) the following documents:

1. Theses of a scientific report, the content of which should reflect certain aspects of one of these areas. Abstracts should be properly edited, since they will be published **in the author's edition** (the file name should be signed in Ukrainian or English in accordance with the name of the conference participant and should contain the word "theses" in the second part (*for example, Петренко\_тезу or Peterenko\_tezu*).

2. Application for participation in the conference (the file name must be signed in Ukrainian or English in accordance with the name of the conference participant and must contain the word "application" in the second part (for example, *Петренко\_заявка or Petrenko\_zayavka*).

***You can send no more than one abstract of one author to the Organizing Committee.***

***It is allowed to submit an abstract of a scientific report in co-authorship (no more than 3 authors per one abstract).***

***Applicants for higher education submit their materials only in co-authorship with the scientific supervisor or with an indication of his scientific guidance.***

***A collection of conference abstracts and a certificate of participation (optional) will be sent to the conference participants to the postal address specified in the application within a month after the conference.***



## **ATTENTION, IMPORTANT!**

In order to maintain a high level of publications and the authority of the Conference, the Organizing Committee is authorized to convey to the conference participants a special opinion on the requirements for materials that are submitted:

1. The Organizing Committee does not aim to attract as many participants as possible – the priority is only the scientific nature of the material, its theoretical and practical significance, the academic integrity of the authors.

2. The Organizing Committee, according to paragraphs 3.13.4-3.13.11 of the Regulations on the organization and holding of the Conference:

- reserves the right to **select materials** in accordance with the topic. Materials whose design does not meet the specified requirements, submitted in violation of the established deadlines or sent without an application, will not be accepted for consideration, and the manuscripts will not be returned;

- **does not enter into polemics** with the authors, **does not edit** (except for format adjustments) the text and does not make edits that would change its essence. Individual materials can be sent to the members of the expert commission of the relevant scientific profile to establish compliance with the requirements for this type of scientific work;

- **does not check the submitted materials** for plagiarism, the **author is responsible** for the content and reliability of the materials, statistical data and other information;

- if the Organizing Committee receives complaints about the content of the published materials, it reserves the right to send these materials for verification to an Expert Commission, based on the results of the conclusions of which a decision may be made to withdraw materials that have been checked for plagiarism and it was found that they contain elements of academic plagiarism (compilation) with further changes to the corresponding collection of Conference materials and re-sending a new version of the collection of materials to all participants and changes on the official website of the Conference;

- the fact of receipt of claims and the results of the conclusions of the Expert Commission are reported by the author (the authors of the theses of the scientific report), the supervisor (for applicants of higher education) and the person who expressed the corresponding claims, and in case of confirmation of the claims – the institution/institution where the author works/studies, as well as all participants of the conference during the submission of the corrected version of the collection;

- practices the policy of free dissemination of scientific information and immediate open access to published content. All materials are placed indefinitely and free of charge immediately after the publication of the collection of the next meeting of the Conference. Full-text access in real time to the abstracts of scientific reports is available on the official website of the Ministry of Internal Affairs in the section "Scientific work";

- users are allowed to read, download, copy, distribute, print, search or link to the full texts of the Conference materials without first asking the permission of the Organizing Committee or the author. This corresponds to the definition of open access by the BOAI (Budapest Open Access Initiative);

- The Organizing Committee follows the recommendations of The Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE) on the ethics of scientific publications.

## **REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DESIGN OF ABSTRACTS OF SCIENTIFIC REPORTS**

The volume of scientific abstracts is up to 5 pages, text editor – Microsoft Word, orientation – book, margins –all 20 mm typeface-Times New Roman, kegel-14, line spacing-1.

The first line is the name of the section (font in italics, kegel – 12, alignment is on the right).

The second line is the author's first and last name (bold italics, centered alignment).

The third line is the scientific degree, academic title, position, course, place of study (work), city, country (font in italics, centered alignment).

The fourth line is the title of the report (in capital letters, bold font, centered alignment).

Next is the text of the report, aligned in width with an indentation on the left of 1.25 cm.

References in the text are made in square brackets [2, p. 56], where the first number means the ordinal number in the list of sources used, the second number means the page number.

The list of references is placed at the end of the text and should be designed in accordance with the existing standards of the bibliographic description of the country of the conference participant (in Ukraine – in accordance with the National Standard of Ukraine DSTU 8302:2015 "Information and Documentation. Bibliographic reference. General provisions and rules of compilation").

When making links to an electronic resource of remote access, if necessary, use URL shortening tools (for example <https://bitly.com/>).
